## The Year as it went by – Annual Report 2022-23

Good Morning Everyone!

1. Hon'ble Chief Guest, distinguished Dignitaries, Parents, members of the Press and Media, Staff Members, dear Cadets, Ladies and Gentlemen! At the outset, I extend a warm welcome to each and every one of you on the occasion of the 20th Annual Day of Sainik School Gopalganj. We sincerely appreciate your being here today with us and for the generous acclaim you have bestowed upon our cadets.

2. Ladies and gentlemen, the cultural programme that our Cadets presented today is the reflection of the diverse array of their creative thoughts. It is evident that the cadets of Sainik School Gopalganj, during their time here, not only focus on rigorous academics but also actively engage themselves in their overall development. I am optimistic that the talent and skills, that the Cadets exhibited, are essential for shaping them into accomplished and capable citizens in future.

3. On this occasion, being the leader of Team Gopalganj, today I stand before you all to present the Annual Report of the school for the Session 2022 - 23 with a deep sense of pride. It is the pride in our Staff and pride in my Cadets. This year has been exceptionally eventful, providing us with numerous moments of success and joy. Throughout the year the dedicated Staff and Cadets of Sainik School Gopalganj have admirably demonstrated their sincere dedication and sagacity that the school expects from them.

4. We began our Academic Session with the admission of a fresh batch of 80 Cadets into our institution. The initial period was primarily focused on orienting the new Cadets and settling them down into the School's regular routines. Meanwhile, the Class XII Cadets started on an intensive training program in preparation for their upcoming UPSC NDA Written Examination, which included special preparatory classes organized by the school. During the session 2022-23, the School bid farewell to the former Principal, Col T Chakravarty, who concluded his three-year tenure and went on to assume a significant role as Col GS (Education) at the prestigious HQ 33 Corps. As we welcomed a new chapter, the school introduced Sqn Ldr Piyush Kumar as the new Administrative Officer and I feel honored to assume the role of the new Principal.

5. In the beginning of this Academic Year, we received the results of the previous Academic Year's Board Exams. I'm delighted to announce that Sainik School Gopalganj achieved a remarkable 100% pass rate in Class XII, while our Class X Cadets, who have now progressed to Class XI, achieved the highest overall Board Results among all 33 Sainik Schools. We narrowly missed achieving this remarkable feat in both Class XII and Class X results, but we are committed to rectify this in future and secure the top results among all Sainik Schools. In the Class X CBSE Board Exams, out of a total of 64 Cadets, an impressive 40 scored above 90%, setting a new record. Furthermore, in the Class XII CBSE Senior Secondary Examination, 32 out of 58 Cadets achieved Distinction marks. These outstanding accomplishments reflect our dedication to Academic Excellence.

6. Despite facing numerous challenges in our temporary location, we remained dedicated to the academic pursuits of our Cadets throughout the year. We diligently managed both pedagogic progress and provided remedial sessions for the Cadets who needed extra effort. As a result, our Cadets performed exceptionally well in the Annual Examinations of all the classes.

7. Furthermore, our Cadets have been consistently delivering outstanding performances on the Regional and National platforms. They have excelled in various prestigious programmes such as the Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan (VVM) Examination, Knowledge and Awareness Mapping Platform (KAMP), Youth Exchange Programme (YEP), National Youth Programme and several other noteworthy initiatives. Today I feel proud to showcase a few of these remarkable accomplishments:

(a) **VVM Exam:** From our school, 240 Cadets participated in the VVM Exam and out of them total 09 Cadets qualified for the subsequent State Level Examination. Subsequently, Cdt Arnav Biswal (1308) of class X and Cdt Kamran Nawaj (1517) of class VII became the toppers of state level VVM Exam and qualified for the National Level Exam. Both the Cadets appeared the exam which was conducted at Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, Thiruvananthapuram. Cdt Kamaraj Nawaj (VII) qualified the National Level Exam and finally attended the Srijan Internship Program in July 2023 at Jerusalem College of Engineering, Chennai.

(b) **Youth Exchange Programme:** Cdt Saket Ranjan (Sch No 1034) of Class XII participated in the Youth Exchange Programme which was held in Vietnam. Out of thirteen Cadets selected nationwide, Cdt Saket emerged as the only candidate chosen through a National-Level Competition organised by NCC Directorate. He stands as the sole representative from the Bihar & Jharkhand Directorate of NCC. Notably, he stood as the exclusive representative from the Bihar & Jharkhand Directorate of NCC. Throughout this period, Cdt Saket actively engaged in a multitude of official programs hosted by the Government of Vietnam. His involvement not only represented his own achievements but also provided valuable international exposure to NCC Cadets from across India.

(c) **Mountaineering Expedition:** Sainik Schools Society organised an All India Sainik School Mountaineering Expedition to Shitidhar Peak, which stands at 5294 Mtr in Manali Region of Himachal Pradesh. This initiative was conducted under overall co-ordination of Sainik School Kunjpura. It is with immense pride we announce the successful completion of this demanding expedition by Cadet Vishal Kumar (Sch No. 1077) and Cadet Mrityunjay Kumar (Sch No. 1111) of Class XII of this school successfully completed the challenging expedition programme. Their accomplishment not only demonstrates their prowess but also enriches their life with invaluable experience.

(d) **National Aerospace Programme:** Two of our Cadets, Cdt Ayush Jha (Sch No. 1265) and Cdt Abhishek Ranjan (Sch No. 1242) of Class X, had the privilege of participating in 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Aerospace Programme,' which was held in Bengaluru.

(e) **CBSE Heritage Quiz Competition:** Our School Quiz Team successfully qualified both the 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the CBSE Heritage Quiz, which was held in Patna. Subsequently, the team advanced to the Regional Level and secured an impressive 4<sup>th</sup> position among the 30 competing teams of the region.

(f) **CBSE Regional Science Exhibition:** A team of 03 Cadets accompanied by a Faculty member of our School took part in the CBSE Regional Science Exhibition 2022-23. With great enthusiasm, the team skillfully showcased their innovative Science Projects during the event which was hosted in Patna. We are delighted to share the news that our School Team secured a remarkable 7<sup>th</sup> position and was recognized among the top 10 projects out of total 58 projects from various participating schools. The accomplishment at the Regional Level fills us with immense pride.

(g) **All India Sainik Schools National Games:** A team of four Cadets, accompanied by a Faculty Member from our school, participated in the All India Sainik Schools National Games held at Sainik School Kunjpura. It is noteworthy that our school achieved significant success by securing two Gold Medals and One Bronze Medal. Out of the four Cadets, Cdt Kajal Kumari (School No. 1553) emerged victorious in the 100 meters race within the Girls' Category by earning a gold medal. Similarly, Cdt Mukund Singh (School No. 1408) excelled in the 400 meters race and clinched another Gold Medal. Cdt Sachin Kumar (School No. 142) achieved a commendable performance in the 100 meters race and earned a well-deserved Bronze Medal whereas, Cdt Niharika Kumari (School No. 1458) got 5<sup>th</sup> position in the Long Jump event and received a Participation Certificate. This outstanding performance by our Cadets at the National Games is a remarkable achievement for the School.

8. Since Mathematics is a crucial subject for both CBSE and NDA Written Exams, we prioritize its importance. To enhance the Mathematical Skills of the Cadets and instill confidence in their Maths Solving Abilities, we organized a 'Maths-Magic' Workshop based on Vedic Mathematics for the Cadets of classes VI to XI. The workshop was skillfully conducted by Mr Devesh Kumar, a Mathematician from the Mathematical Institute for Genius, Jamshedpur. The workshop proved to be an invaluable opportunity for the Cadets.

9. The Cadets of Class XII have received dedicated academic support in their preparations for their UPSC NDA Examination. In the session 2022-23, 20 of our Cadets successfully qualified the UPSC NDA Written Exams for 'NDA Courses 150 & 151', and as of now, 04 have already been recommended. Ladies and Gentlemen, today, I am delighted to announce one of our remarkable accomplishments. This year we achieved an extraordinary milestone with 23 out of 54 of our Cadets successfully qualified the UPSC NDA Written Examination, marking a historic achievement over the last decade. This is the second best result among all the 33 Sainik Schools in the country. These Cadets are now under specialized training for their up-coming SSB Interviews.

10. This outstanding Academic Achievement doesn't merely serve as a laurel for us; rather, we view it as vast responsibility. The Academic Team and the Cadets have set this lofty standard, which we must not only maintain but also strive to surpass with each subsequent endeavour. Ladies and Gentlemen! I can confidently assure you today that you can expect an even higher level of performance from the school in near future.

Today's woman educates her children properly so that they can also know their rights and become aware of their duties as responsible citizens. Thus, an empowered woman can actually empower the whole so-

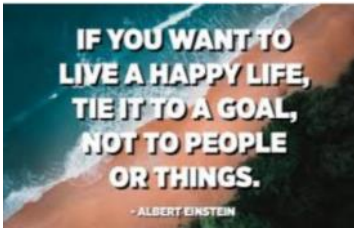
ciety. That is why; women empowerment is the need of the hour in order to transform India into a developed nation.

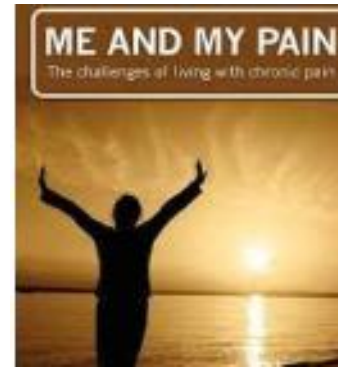

Sarojini Naidu, Kasturba Gandhi, Vijayalakmi Pundit and Annie Bezzant in the 20th century are the names which are remembered even today for their singular contribution both in battlefield and in political field. Finally, it can be said that the role of women in our freedom struggle is commendable.

## WORLD'S OCEANS ARE JUST ONE BIG NETWORK

As fish populations decrease globally, researchers assert that the focus should be on working with other countries rather than on just local numbers, why is this? Come, let's find out.

Political boundaries are work of humans. Wildlife do not recognise them. And, fish are no different. Dwelling in water bodies, they freely cross countries. Studies have indicated that there a few fish species that "migrate over long distances". As it happens , fish egg and larvae may originate in one place and be carried to far-away places ( this could be to even other countries), thanks to ocean currents. "often one nation's fish stocks depend on the spawning grounds of a neighbouringcountry , where fish release eggs and sperm into the water and larvae hatched from fertilized eggs.

A recent study has discovered that "global fisheries are even more tightly connected than previously". With fish and spawn connected to several regions, the worlds coastal marine fisheries are necessarily "a single network" aided by ocean currents. Ocean current patterns vary with seasons. But , mostly these currents patterns are sluggish (though there are a few regions have the currents are faster).

Despite this , spawn can travel far. Here's an example, even a gentle current of 0.1 miles per hour can carry spawn 40 miles over a months. Add to this a fact that different fish species spawn in several months at different locations , and what we get is fish species in one country steadily arriving from or drifting to other countries over different periods of time.

So, what happens is that if fish population in one region dwindle , “the amount of fish spawn ,or eggs and larvae , riding the ocean currents from there to other countries would also decline dramatically , resulting in further loss of fish elsewhere”. To ensure food security and employment to those dependent on fishing, it is important for countries to understand this deep interconnectedness of global waters and chalk out ways to guard them.

## EVM VS BALLOT PAPER



Elections in India are conducted through electronics voting machine (EVMS) and paper

ballots. Nowadays, elections in India are always a festive fair .It is the biggest proof of our democratic values and respect for the constitution. People over the age of 18 years are allowed to cast their votes and choose their representatives through votes, making their citizenships count and develop the society. Election season has put together a series that seeks to deconstruct various aspects of the massive democratic exercise to make every citizen aware of its history, processes, rules and other relevant information. Free and fair elections are must for a thriving democracy, as it covers voters' preferences into a political mandate that forms the basis for policy making.

Elections in India using EVMs started more than 30 years after getting independence, until then ballots were used. Finding that there were many malpractices like rigging , forged voting, booth capturing with muscle powers, time consumption in getting the ballot paper get packed and to the wastage of tons of paper during elections process, the Election Commission of India (ECI) thought of a better way of giving voting rights to citizens. Then EVMs were introduced. EVMs in India were developed and tested by the Bharat Electronics Ltd. and Electronics Corporation of India Ltd.

Accordingly, first time use of EVMs occurred in the general election in Kerala in May, 1982; however, the absence of a specific law prescribing its use led to the Supreme Court striking down that election.

Subsequently, in 1989, the Parliament amended the Representation of the People Act, 1951 to create a provision for the use of EVMs in the elections (chapter 3). A general consensus on its introduction could be reached only in 1998 and these were used in 25 Legislative Assembly constituencies spread across three states of Madhya Pradesh, Rajasthan and Delhi. Its use was further expanded in 1999 to 45 Parliamentary Constituencies and later, in February 2000, to 45 Assembly Constituencies of the Haryana Assembly elections. In the State Assembly elections, held in May 2001, in the states of Tamil Nadu, Kerala, Puducherry and West Bengal, the EVMs were used in all the Assembly Constituencies. Since then, for every State Assembly election, the Commission has used the EVMs. In 2004, in the General Election to the Lok Sabha, the EVMs (more than one million) were used in all 543 Parliamentary Constituencies in the country.

The Economic Intelligence Unit, while measuring our democracy index, gave India's Electoral process a score of 9.17 on 10. This success is mostly owed to the ECI.

Now, let us know about the differences between EVMs and ballots paper to see which is better in the interest of democracy, which are:

1. EVMs are easier to transport compared to ballot boxes as they are lighter, more portable, and come with polypropylene carrying cases. Voting is also faster in places where illiteracy is high, people find EVMs easier than ballot Paper systems.

2. EVMs provide faster result announce-

ment, elimination of miscounting of votes or the simplicity of the vote casting method. The system has become faster and more trustworthy while others still believe that ballot paper has no chance of being hacked. However in this regard, the ECI threw an open hacking challenge in June 2017 for whoever claimed that the EVMs could be tampered with. This challenge came amidst various claims by cyber experts that they could be hacked and pre-programmed. Among the most prominent cases was the cyber expert Syed Shuja who claimed via a Skype Interview from London that he was among the developers of the machine and could hack EVM. However, his claims were proven invalid when he could not hack the machine.

3. In the paper ballot method of voting, if the stamp is not put properly it will be counted as an invalid vote. With EVMs this problem will be eliminated. Though developed countries went back to paper ballots, for them it won't take much effort because of their small population, and hence we cannot say that it is apt for all countries. Decisions should be taken based on all the factors involved.

Therefore, keeping all the facts in the right perspective, it can be said that EVM is better than ballot paper till date. In the era of emerging technology, time will decide if we find any other better way of casting votes.

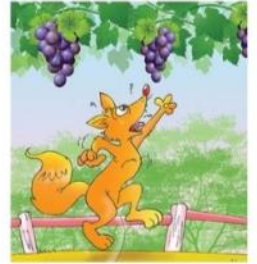

## चंद्रयान 3



चंद्रयान 3 भारत का तीसरा चंद्र मिशन है, जो 2023 में प्रक्षेपित किया जाएगा। इस मिशन का उद्देश्य चंद्रमा के दक्षिणी ध्रुव पर सतही सम्पर्क करना है, और चंद्रमा की सतह, संरचना, सामग्री, और पानी के संकेतों का अध्ययन करना है। चंद्रयान 3 भारत का महत्वाकांक्षी चंद्र मिशन है। चंद्रयान 3 ने सफलतापूर्वक चंद्रमा के दक्षिणी ध्रुव पर सॉफ्ट-लैंडिंग की है। चंद्रयान 3 चंद्रमा पर होने वाले सभी वैज्ञानिक कार्यों में सबसे महत्वपूर्ण है, और भारत में अंतरिक्ष अनुसंधान के क्षेत्र में भी। चंद्रयान 3 मिशन को पूरा करने के लिए, लगभग 15 साल की कड़ी मेहनत की ज़रूरत पड़ी। 15 साल की लगातार मेहनत और अनुसंधान के बाद, आज भारत सरकार अपना यान चंद्रमा पर पहुंचा पाई है। भारतीय अंतरिक्ष संस्था (ISRO) ने 14 जुलाई, 2023 को चंद्रमा पर प्रक्षेपित किया। मिशन के उद्देश्यों को प्राप्त करने के लिए, प्रक्षेपक में कई उन्नत प्रौद्योगिकियों हैं, जैसे-लेजर, RF-प्रकार का समुन्नत, समुन्नत, प्रोपलसन सिस्टम, इन प्रौद्योगिकियों को पृथ्वी की स्थितियों में सफलतापूर्वक प्रदर्शित करने के लिए, कई प्रक्षेपक-विशिष्ट परीक्षण योजना बनाए गए हैं और सफलतापूर्वक पूरे किए गए हैं, जैसे, समेकित शीत परीक्षण, समेकित गरम परीक्षण और प्रक्षेपक पॉव मैकेनिज्म प्रदर्शन परीक्षण। चंद्रयान 3 के माध्यम से, भारत का लक्ष्य है, अपनी तकनीकी कौशल, वैज्ञानिक क्षमता और अंतरिक्ष अन्वेषण के प्रति प्रतिबद्धता को प्रमाणित करना है। यदि चंद्रयान 3 सफल होता है, तो यह भारत की अंतर्राष्ट्रीय अंतरिक्ष समुदाय में स्थिति को मज़बूत करेगा। यह मिशन युवा पीढ़ी को विज्ञान, प्रौद्योगिकी, इंजीनियरिंग और गणित (STEM) में कैरियर का पीछा करने के लिए प्रेरित करेगा। चंद्रयान 3 भारत के लिए एक गर्व की उपलब्धि है और अंतरिक्ष अन्वेषण के इतिहास में एक मील का पत्थर है।

यह मिशन हमें चंद्रमा को बेहतर समझने में मदद करेगा और भविष्य के मिशनों के लिए उसकी क्षमता का अन्वेषण करेगा।

## भारत और चीन संबंध

भारत और चीन दोनों प्राचीन सभ्यताओं और प्रमुख विकासशील देशों हैं। ये दोनों ही प्रमुख विकासशील देशों और उभरती अर्थव्यवस्थाओं के महत्वपूर्ण प्रतिनिधि हैं, इसलिए भारत-चीन संबंधों का वैश्विक और रणनीतिक महत्व है। 2020 का महत्व: 2020 में भारत और चीन के बीच राजनयिक संबंध स्थापित होने का 70वां वर्षगांठ मनाया गया। दोनों देशों में बड़ी आबादी, बहुत बड़ा ग्रामीण-शहरी अंतर, बढ़ती हुई अर्थव्यवस्था, पड़ोसियों के साथ संघर्ष सहित समान गुण-दोष हैं। भारत और चीन ने विभिन्न स्तरों पर कई संवाद तंत्र स्थापित किए हैं, जो द्विपक्षीय राजनीतिक, आर्थिक, सांस्कृतिक, जन-जन, कॉन्सुलर मामलों के साथ-साथ क्षेत्रीय और वैश्विक मुद्दों पर संवादों को शामिल करते हैं। 21वीं सदी की शुरुआत से, भारत और चीन के बीच व्यापार \$3 अरब से कम से \$100 अरब के करीब पहुंच गया है, लगभग 32 गुना की बढ़ोतरी। भारत-चीन संबंध "प्रतिस्पर्धा, सहयोग, और मतभेद" से भरे हुए हैं। पिछले कुछ वर्षों में, इनका प्रकाशन ऐसी घटनाओं में हुआ है, जैसे, भारत का चीन की बेल्ट एंड रोड पहल (BRI) का आलोचना करना, भारत का शंघाई सहयोग संगठन (SCO) में प्रवेश करना, डोकलाम और गलवान घाटी में हुए नाटकीय संकट, BRICS में बहुपक्षीय सहयोग को तेज करना, और आर्थिक सम्बन्धों को मज़बूत करने की कोशिशें भारत और चीन के अपने-अपने सीमा क्षेत्रों के बारे में अलग-अलग धारणाएं हैं, जिसके कारण कई सैन्य संघर्ष और गतिरोध हुए हैं। दोनों देशों के क्षेत्रीय और वैश्विक मुद्दों, जैसे, आतंकवाद, मानवाधिकार, जलवायु परिवर्तन, आदि पर भी अलग-अलग विचार हैं। इन मतभेदों को संवाद और पारस्परिक सम्मान के माध्यम से हल करना होगा।

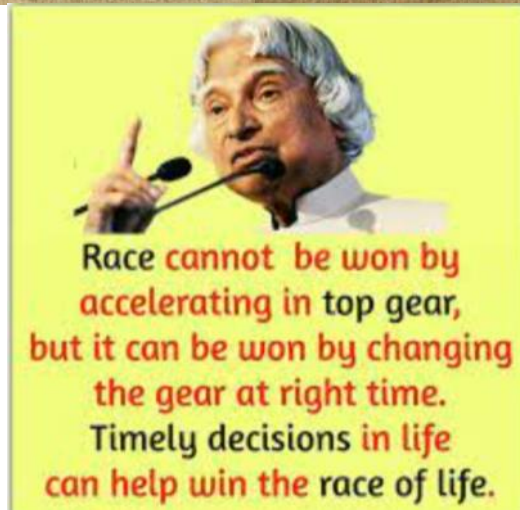

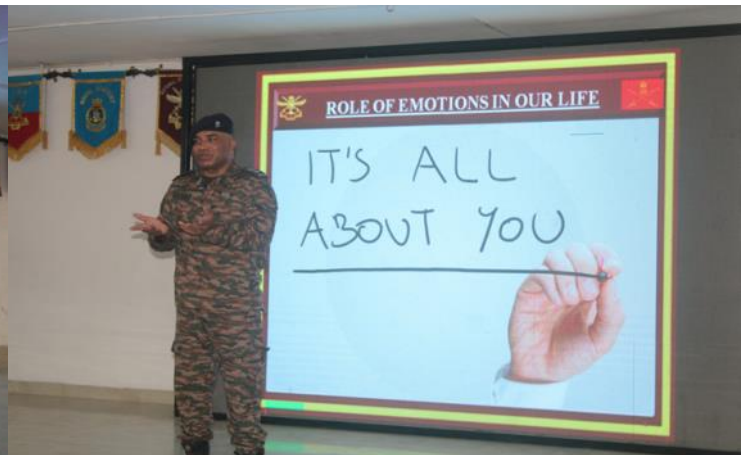
